

The Island of Goli



This is a barren and inhabited island in northern Adriatic that has once been the infamous jail for political prisoners. Nowadays, it is an excursion sight and a reminder of the unnecessary human suffering. The island is located between Rab's northeastern coast and the mainland. The walls of Goli descend down to over 60 meters of depth and the most known abis is Macinj, or, as some call it, Double Rock. Moreover, there is also a shoal spot descending down, on its outer side, to 70 meters, where you can see big gorgonians. It is very suitable for Trimix and Tech diving.
