



The Rock of Mag

Rab is surrounded by very steep walls, the abis as we call them. These walls are covered in yellow and brown sponges, various types of sea grass, anemones and not to mention gorgonians ranging in colour from yellow, dark blue, brown, to the typical red and at some places completely white as if made from lace.

Mag is a 200 meter long reef whose north side falls from 4 to 60 meters of depth, overgrown with different gorgonians and full of gaps and cuttings among which you can usually find a catfish calmly sleeping on its shelf. We can also meet different species of fish, the European lobsters and of course octopuses. At times, there are so many octopuses that the divers themselves name this position the Octopus Reef.
